



Caerfai Bay Caravan and Tent Park

Tent Hire



We have three Nepal Super tents for hire, each will take up to 6 persons, but there are no divisions (a little pop up tent can be placed inside if necessary). They are specially selected to suit our location – opening at the front there is a fine view towards St Brides Bay and Ramsey Island. When more shelter is required, the ‘view’ openings can be firmly secured, and an opening at the opposite end can be used. The tent will be erected for you before you arrive – arrival times 3p.m. onwards, but see note below. Unless you request a different pitch, it will normally be on the coastal side of Field 3. It is ‘just a tent’, you will need to bring your own bedding and cooking equipment. Please note we do not allow dogs in our hire tents.

GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS

The Caravan and Tent Park is on the RIGHT at the end of the Caerfai Road – DO NOT CONFUSE US WITH THE FARM CAMPSITE WHICH IS ON THE LEFT. Please call at the office at the top of the caravan park when you arrive to pay any balance due, and receive your pitch information. Last arrival 9p.m. If you anticipate an arrival later than 5.30p.m. (or 4.30p.m. in the off season) please telephone the office on the day to check arrangements.

Caerfai Bay Caravan and Tent Park is approximately 10 acres; the first field, approx. 4½ acres is allocated for caravans and motor homes only; the adjacent two fields are for tents and motor homes (Fields 2 and 3). There are toilet/shower blocks with baby changing facilities in the caravan field and the first tent field. In the tent field there is also a family amenity block, dish-wash room and small kitchen (Microwave and toaster). Washing of crockery and utensils should be carried out in the dish-wash rooms - never under the standpipes where water can be wasted. Laundry, dish-wash, basic cooking facilities, Wi-Fi etc. is situated under one roof in the caravan field and can be used by all our visitors. All hot water is free. The laundry has coin-operated washing machines, dryers and iron/ironing board. There is an adjacent outside drying area. Wet suits are not allowed in the toilet and shower blocks. A wet suit wash is situated next to the amenity block in field 2.

Refund policy due to weather: We do not refund deposits where advance bookings have been made nor do we refund payments on the basic rate if campers have left early due to bad weather. The extra charges (shown overleaf) will be refunded on nights not stayed.

In addition we ask you to abide by the few conditions listed below:

- The entrance gate is also the only exit from the park, and the park is in the main surrounded by private farmland. Visitors are asked to respect the integrity of the boundary hedges, and not to climb over them or remove stones. If balls etc. need to be retrieved, please ask the staff for help.
- Some of the park is sloping, and cars should be parked across the slope for safety reasons. There is a speed limit of 10mph, and 5mph where there are ramps.
- Parents are to be responsible for their children at all times whilst on the Park.
- Please keep children well away from grass cutting machinery whilst in use or stationary.
- An adult should accompany children under 7 years to the toilet, and under 11 years to the showers.
- From the safety aspect, skateboards and roller skates are not allowed; guns, air guns, catapults and kites are not permitted on the park.
- Please respect each camper’s area, and make sure your children do not cause a nuisance to neighbouring pitches, especially with ball games and the like.
- Remember, sound carries through tent walls, so please keep noise to a minimum, especially late evening and at night. Between the hours of 10pm and 8am, motor vehicles must be kept as quiet as possible and no sound producing equipment is to be audible.
- If Park rules are persistently broken, especially with respect to noise and nuisance to neighbours, such campers may be asked to leave.
- Visitors may not use metal detectors, Chinese lanterns or drones on the park.
- Barbeques are permitted but must be kept at least 2ft off the ground – you can hire barbeque stands from the office. You will incur a fine if the ground has been damaged. NEVER LEAVE A BARBEQUE INSIDE YOUR TENT OR AWNING – POISONOUS GASES MAY STILL BE GENERATED.
- Please place all refuse in skip bins or appropriate waste recycling containers located in the skip enclosure. Never leave refuse bags outside your tent as they may be strewn across the field by seagulls etc. We have neighbouring badgers that will also rummage for your food – please keep it contained and away from temptation!
- Any person found using illegal drugs on the Park will be asked to leave – there is zero tolerance to drugs.
- There is a ‘No Smoking’ policy in all buildings on the Park.
- Avoid the risk of fire: please make sure you use and store electrical and gas equipment and flammables safely. Do not allow rubbish to accumulate and keep flammable items away from flames and hot surfaces. Do not use open fires – with the exception of barbeques at a safe distance from the ground and neighbouring units. In the event of a fire, evacuate the tent immediately. Only use extinguishers if it is safe to do so.
